This funding will be used to

- Maintain 100% QCE attainment and greater than or equal to 80% OPs in the 1-15 range.
- Work towards 100% of Year 7 and Year 9 students attaining NAPLAN results in Reading, and Numeracy greater than or equal to National Minimum Standards.
- Increase the percentage of Year 7 and Year 9 students achieving in the upper two bands of NAPLAN Reading and Numeracy to levels similar to or greater than the national average.
- Embed and improve Explicit Teaching in every teacher's pedagogy in every classroom.
- Strive to maintain and/or increase attendance at greater than 90% across all year levels.

Our initiatives include

- Professional development, coaching and feedback to embed Explicit Teaching in every teacher's pedagogy and classroom.
- Embedding a culture of classroom observation and feedback to support and encourage reflective practice.
- Focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against their year level achievement standards and/or chosen pathways.
- Provision of resources, human, financial and physical, to assist in the attainment of identified targets.
- Supporting improved health and well-being of staff and students.

Implementing and supporting through professional development and a workforce reform initiative a coaching and feedback program for teachers in school based approaches to pedagogy, essential skills in classroom management and explicit teaching. Providing professional development in behaviour management. Implementation of strategies for the improved personal health and well-being of staff and students.	\$100,000
Employment of human resources targeted at priority learning areas identified to improve student achievement, improve attendance, maintain 100% QCE attainment, improve VET qualification completions and OP attainment levels. Including but not limited to Youth Worker, Teacher/s, Student Support Worker, Indigenous Support Worker, Teacher Aides and non-DET instructors with relevant expertise to assist achieving targeted outcomes.	\$130,000
