## Subject Selection Survey – Year 11 2017



### Steps in Selecting a Course of Study:

1. Complete **Section 1: Subject Selection Planning**.
2. Use Section 1 to decide whether you will be selecting the **AUTHORITY STUDIES** pathway or the **VOCATIONAL STUDIES** pathway.
3. Decide which subjects, within your chosen pathway, you wish to take.
  - AUTHORITY STUDIES students will select English (mandatory), either Maths B or Maths A and four (4) elective subjects. (TOTAL – 6 subjects)
    - When making your selection, please consider the 'best fit' combination in order to maximise your opportunities in your selected university course.
  - VOCATIONAL STUDIES students will select either English or English Communications and either Pre Vocational Maths, Maths A or Maths B. Students, in the VOCATIONAL STUDIES pathway, will select three (3) elective subjects. (TOTAL – 5 subjects selected)
4. Print clearly (in BLACK/BLUE ink) your subject choices in the appropriate table in **Section 2: Subject Selection**
5. **Return this signed Subject Selection Survey form to the school office no later than Friday 19<sup>th</sup> August, 2016.**
6. **A personal interview** will be set up involving yourself, Mrs Wenban and Mrs Kelly. This will occur in week 10 – between Monday 12<sup>th</sup> and Friday 16<sup>th</sup> September. At this meeting, your subject choices will be reviewed to allow you to receive feedback about how your subjects will support your goals and contribute to your **Queensland Certificate of Education** points and, if applicable, an **Overall Position** score.
7. At this meeting, your final subject selections will be lodged online and a letter will be provided for you and your parents to you to confirm your selection. Parents/carers are welcome to a) be part of this interview process or b) meet with Mrs Kelly or Mrs Wenban after your discussion.
8. Once all students have made selections, the timetabling process for Year 11 will commence.
9. Once the timetabling process that relates to Year 11 subject lines has been completed, you and your parents/carers will receive a final confirmation of your successful selection for subjects for Year 11, 2017.
